Prevent is part of the UK government's counter-terrorism strategy and aims not only to stop people becoming terrorists but to challenge and prevent support of terrorism, radicalisation and extremism, while at the same time protecting the public. There are different types of terrorism, and Prevent deals with all of them

 - Spotting the signs of Radicalisation
 - In depth guidance on the Prevent referral procedure and Practice.
